Health Effects of Exposure to Radiation Q&A

Q: Do you have any radiation accidents that have been reported in Canada since 2010. If so, how many accidents and what were the consequences?

A: There have not been any major events that would have had widespread consequences in Canada since 2010. Reportable events are published by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission: <u>https://nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/acts-and-regulations/event-reports-for-major-nuclear-facilities/index.cfm</u>

Q: The reported events start in the year 2020. How can I get information before this date?

A: If you enter the terms, "events reporting" into the search bar on the CNSC website, you will get historical results. Alternatively, you can visit this page <u>https://nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/acts-and-regulations/event-reports-for-major-nuclear-facilities/index.cfm</u> on their site and use the links provided to navigate to incidents for specific sectors. You could also contact the CNSC to request the information.
